## How to participate?

The project Let's not WASTE the planet is financed by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union as well as by the Franco-German Youth Office. Thanks to this support, travel costs within the allowances of the Erasmus+ guidelines are covered. A participation fee of 60 EUR for participants from France or Germany and 150 PLN for participants from Poland applies.

The participants will be chosen according to their motivation and in order to create a group as diverse as possible in all regards. Priority will be given to those who are able to participate in all three parts of the project. A first selection of participants will start around the end of July 2020.

We are keen on offering you an exchange in real life but will of course adapt our concept in order to achieve a safe and healthy experience for our participants and our team!
